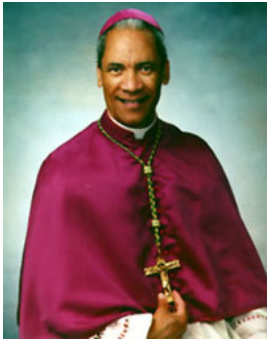

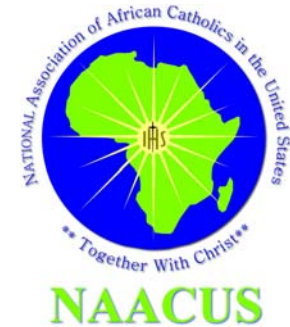

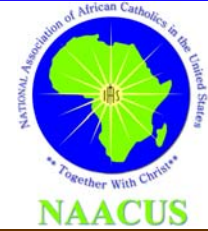
Vibrant, visible, nurturing African Catholic communities Enriching the Church and Catholic ministries in the United States.

MISSION STATEMENT

Objectives
